



2015/16 Rescue Overview

It's fair to say that 2016 has been an exciting but busy year which has seen the Kerry Blue Terrier Rescue evolve at an incredible pace.

On 5th June 2016 the rescue added to its Facebook page by launching its own website and to date we have had nearly 16,500 people visit the site.

To further evolve and ensure the longevity of the rescue it was decided that the best way forward was to put the rescue on a more secure footing and so in September 2016 the rescue was set up formally as a not for profit making organisation.

By doing this it created a number of roles within the rescue. Mark Buckley became the rescue's Managing Director and National Rehoming Coordinator, Bridie Moriarty became the Rescue Director, Emma Bendel agreed to be the rescue's treasurer and Jeremy Corke the Rescue's secretary.

In November a further role was added for an aftercare coordinator which was duly filled by Judy Warner.

In December Gayle Don agreed to be the rescue's Scotland coordinator and further regional coordinator roles agreed by Paul Busby and Nell Carter.

In December the rescue also introduced its own Instagram page as well to further modernise the rescue and broaden the rescue reach.
