The Skye Munros

We have been contacted by Shona Marshall, a very kind supporter of ours who would like to raise funds for the Rescue. Following on from the success of her Loch Ness 360 Challenge in 2019 when she walked 82 miles in 26 hours, she has suggested another adventure of a more vertical kind! Shona and her Kerry Blue 'Betty' will attempt to climb the Inaccessible Pinnacle, the most challenging peak in the Skye Cuillin ridge. At 986m it is not the highest of the Skye Munros but bagging the 'In Pin' involves some climbing and an abseil off the top! Since neither she nor Betty has experience of this, they will be accompanied by a guide for this and the other 10 Munro peaks of the Cuillin ridge from 2nd to 5th May, with Bla Bheinn, a stand-alone Munro being climbed on either the 1st or 6th, dependent on weather conditions. Shona says that this will be as much a mental as physical challenge as many of the ridge paths are extremely narrow with vertiginous drops. These mountains are regarded as the toughest of the 282 Munros with every day's walk beginning at sea level.
